Objectives: 2007

- Simplify the Regulations, (to make them easier to apply to the diverse range of contractual arrangements)
- Improve co-ordination (by creating a 'client advisor' role of the CDM coordinator (CDM-c);
- Improve client focus;
- Increase the focus on competence assessment; and bear down on bureaucracy.




Temporary Works Yours, Mine or Ours?

Objectives: 2015

- implement the Temporary or Mobile Construction Sites Directive (TMCSD) in a proportionate way;

- · meet better regulation principles.

- · Client aware of duties.
- Apply general principles of prevention (and content of PCI) to eliminate foreseeable risks relating to construction, maintenance, cleaning and use as a workplace. SfaRP
- Reduce or control risks SfaRP and provide appropriate info. to PD for PCI and H&SF.
- Take reasonable steps to include with design, info. about design/construct/ maintenance to help others.



Temporary Works Yours, Mine or Ours?

PE reg.11 o Design o Control

- Plan manage monitor pre-construction phase & coordinate H&S during pre-construction phase to ensure SfaRP the project is carried out without risks to H&S
- Apply general principles of prevention (and content of CDM documents) to technical, organisational, stage planning, and time aspects of the work.
- Identify, eliminate or control SfaRP foreseeable risks for: construction, maintenance, cleaning, use/workplace.
- · Ensure Designers comply with duties.
- Ensure cooperation with Client, PD and each other.
- · Assist Client with PCI, provide PCI to others. Liaise with PC.
