Objectives: 2007

- **Simplify** the Regulations, (to make them easier to apply to the diverse range of contractual arrangements)
- Improve **co-ordination** (by creating a 'client advisor' role of the CDM coordinator (CDM-c);
- Improve **client** focus;
- Increase the focus on **competence assessment**; and bear down on **bureaucracy**.



Temporary Works Yours, Mine or Ours?

Legislative Intent

Objectives: 2015

- maintain or improve **worker protection**;
- **simplify** the regulatory package;
- **improve** health and safety standards on small construction sites;
- **implement** the Temporary or Mobile Construction Sites Directive (TMCSO) in a proportionate way;
- **discourage bureaucracy**; and
- meet **better regulation** principles.

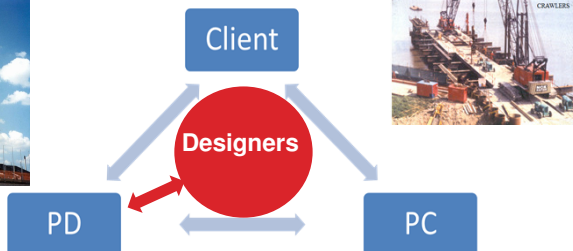

Temporary Works Yours, Mine or Ours?

Designer reg.9

- **Client aware** of duties.
- **Apply general principles of prevention** (and content of PCI) to eliminate foreseeable risks relating to construction, maintenance, cleaning and use as a workplace. **SfaRP**
- **Reduce or control risks SfaRP** and provide appropriate **info.** to PD for PCI and H&SF.
- Take **reasonable steps** to include with design, **info.** about design/construct/ maintenance to help others.



Temporary Works Yours, Mine or Ours?

PE reg.11

- Design
- Control

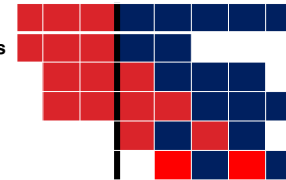
- Plan manage monitor **pre-construction phase** & coordinate H&S during pre-construction phase to ensure **SfaRP** the project is carried out without risks to H&S
- **Apply** general principles of prevention (and content of CDM documents) to technical, organisational, stage planning, and time aspects of the work.
- **Identify, eliminate or control SfaRP** foreseeable risks for: construction, maintenance, cleaning, use/workplace.
- **Ensure Designers comply** with duties.
- **Ensure cooperation** with Client, PD and each other.
- **Assist Client** with PCI, provide PCI to others. Liaise with PC.

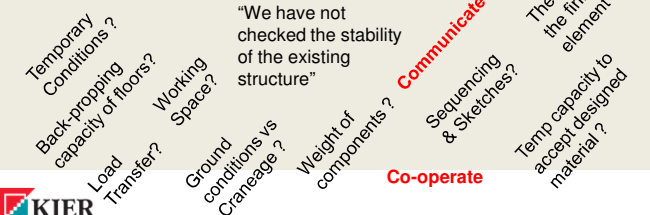
